Gordon Fitzpatrick is President of Fitzpatrick Family Vineyards and was former President of CedarCreek Estate Winery, which was twice **named Canada's Winery of** the Year at the Canadian Wine Awards.

Mr. Fitzpatrick was a member of the founding Board of Directors of Destination BC and was a Member of the Minister's Council on Tourism. Mr. Fitzpatrick also served as Chairman of the B.C. Wine Institute and was a Director of the Canadian Vintners Association. In addition, he is also a Director of Greata Ranch Holding Corporation.
